YOUTH APPLICATION

A summer youth mission trip can be a real life changing experience for teenagers. You will learn that real people live behind the barriers of age, infirmity and poverty. After this experience, it will no longer be possible to look on the needy with a casual glance. This experience will enhance your faith and provide you with the opportunity to make a real difference in the lives of other people...a chance to create changes in their lives and in their world.

Next summer, we will be attending an Appalachia Service Project (ASP) workcamp in West Virginia the week of July 8-14 (departing on the 7th and returning on the 15th). Some key facts:

- This opportunity is open to youth currently in 8th grade through 12th grade.
- Although the cost of a week at the workcamp is \$310 per person, our mission trip fundraisers during the year allow us partially to subsidize each individual. We ask for each youth participant to pay **\$150** (early bird registrations pay only \$125 if the application is received prior to February 19). Financial assistance is available.
- Application Deadline is **March 25, 2012**. After that date we cannot guarantee that spaces will be available.

This serves as your application to join the 2012 ASP Trip.

Upon acceptance, you will receive registration/medical forms to complete. Applications will be accepted on a first come/first served basis.
